It was the second time that Sr. May a resident in Benoni and Eddy House's Nursing sister has been to Israel. In 2010, her debut international, she came back with Gold in the mixed pairs and Silver in the singles.

The medals were a welcome reward for Sr. Homer who had been struggling with her bowling before her knee replacement in 2017.
